25	GGRF G95 would like to thank 3GPP2, TR45.2 and TR46.3 for their work in support of
26	CDMA-GSM roaming.
27	
28	At the March meeting of G95 in Madrid, there was agreement that there is a market need
29	for CDMA Packet Data Service for GSM/GPRS subscribers who roam into a CDMA
30	network. These requirements include support for simultaneous voice and data, simple IP
31	and mobile IP as specified in IS-880. Standards are required to support this capability in
32	the network, handset and R-UIM/SIM.
33	
34	J-STD-038-B is expected to support GPRS Foreign Mode Service for ANSI-41
35	subscribers. The enabling standards are needed for GSM/GPRS subscribers in a CDMA
36	network.
37	
38	GGRF and G95 would appreciate your assistance in addressing these standards
39	requirements and responding with a proposed work plan for each of the relevant working
40	groups. G95 will be meeting again June 19-20 in Mexico and will be happy to undertake
41	coordination of this work.
