








Beijing's Location in China Map







Tian' anmen Square (天安门广场)

Tian'anmen Square, located on East Chang'an Avenue in Dongcheng District of Beijing, has undergone many revisions and changes, and finally formed a large square with a length of 880 meters from north to south, a width of 500 meters from east to west, and an area of 440,000 square meters, which is the largest urban square in the world. The central axis of Tian'anmen Square is in the middle, and the two wings are symmetrical, which can accommodate 1 million people to hold a grand rally. Along the central axis of Beijing, the flagpole, the Monument to the People's Heroes, the Mausoleum of Mao Zedong, and the Zhengyangmen City Gate stand one after another from north to south in the square.



The Great Wall at Badaling (八达岭长城)


The Great Wall at Badaling is located at the northern entrance of the ancient pass of Jundu Mountain in Yanqing District, Beijing. It is an important part of the Great Wall, a Great defensive project in ancient China, and a pass of the Ming Great Wall. It is one of the best preserved and most representative sections of the Ming Great Wall, known as one of the "Nine Passes of the World," and is a must-visit destination in Beijing. The Great Wall at Badaling is located in a strategic position, with a commanding height. The wall is tall and strong, with a dense network of watchtowers, showcasing the outstanding achievements of ancient Chinese architectural art and the wisdom of the working people. In 1987, the Great Wall at Badaling, as an important part of the Great Wall, was listed in the World Cultural Heritage List.





The Palace Museum (故宫博物院)

The Palace Museum, located in the center of Beijing, formerly known as the Forbidden City, is the royal palace of the Ming and Qing dynasties. It is now the largest ancient cultural and art museum in China. It was built in the fourth year of Yongle of the Ming Dynasty (1406 AD) and completed in the eighteenth year of Yongle (1420 AD), passing through 24 emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasties. The architectural style integrates the essence of ancient Chinese palace architecture, with yellow glazed tiles on the roof, red palace walls, and white base as the main features, decorated with exquisite wood carvings, stone carvings, and colorful paintings, reflecting the highest achievement of ancient Chinese architectural art.



The Summer Palace (颐和园)

• The Summer Palace, located in the western suburbs of Beijing, is a royal garden of the Qing Dynasty in China. It was originally known as Qingyi Garden and was built in 1750. It was rebuilt in 1888, after which it was renamed the Summer Palace. It is the most complete royal palace and garden, known as the "Royal Garden Museum", and was listed in the World Cultural Heritage List in 1998.



The Temple of Heaven (天坛)

- The Temple of Heaven is located on the east side of Yongdingmen Street in the Dongcheng District, Beijing. It was the place where the emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasties worshipped Heaven and prayed for bumper crops. The northern part of the outer surrounding wall is semi-circular in shape, while the southern part is square, a pattern symbolic of the ancient belief that Heaven was round and the earth square.
- As a masterpiece of the Ming and Qing architectural art and a precious example of China's ancient architecture, the Temple of Heaven is the largest architectural complex for worshipping Heaven in the world. In 1998, it was listed in the World Cultural Heritage List.





Bird's Nest, Water Cube (鸟巢、水立方)

- The Bird's Nest is a national stadium built for the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games, located in the Beijing Olympic Park. Its design is inspired by the traditional Chinese culture of bird nests, with a unique architectural shape and a large amount of steel structure, forming a huge and interlaced network structure.
- The Water Cube is the main swimming pool built for the 2008 Summer Olympics, located on the south side of the Bird's Nest. The exterior design of the Water Cube is inspired by water bubbles and adopts a unique membrane structure, which has good light transmission and aesthetics.




