

1 Year 2003 MCC Expenditure

1.1 MCC Staff Expenditure (Officers and Assistants)














This chart shows the resources used for the support of the ETSI RT (Railway Telecommunications) activity.

1.3 MCC Travel and Subsistence



A concerted effort has been made to reduce travel and subsistence costs and this is reflected in the year end results. However, it should be noted that in 2003 there have been many more meetings in Europe than in previous years and that this leads to obvious cost savings for MCC. Additional savings have been possible with the increased use of budget airlines.

The MCC expenditure for the year was 518,55 kEUR against a budget allocation of 700 kEUR.

It should be noted that this budget line (700 kEUR) includes a 20 kEUR provision for non-3GPP related travel, whilst the expenditure shown here (518,55 kEUR) is exclusively for 3GPP related travel.

To this has been added the **34 kEUR** of voluntary funding carried forward from a previous codec selection task. Authority for this transfer of funds has been received from the relevant companies who provided the funds

This gives a total 2003 budget allocation of 194 kEUR.
