**1. Overall Description:**

SA3 thanks SA2 for their liaison statement on UE-initiated tunnelling.

SA3 has considered the security of UE-initiated tunnels and a preliminary study has been presented at S3#28. The assumption is that if such a solution was retained for scenario 3, it would require a security mechanism to address potential threats linked to these tunnels. However, it was made known to SA3 that the status of scenario 3 was unstable following the last WLAN ad hoc meeting of SA2 and that the choice of a tunnelling solution was not final.

Therefore SA3 decided to wait for a final decision on the tunnelling solution before committing to specifying a security solution.
