The figures used throughout this report are based on those available on 14 January 2002, and which were further revised on 4 March. They are believed to be accurate and have now been subjected to an external audit.

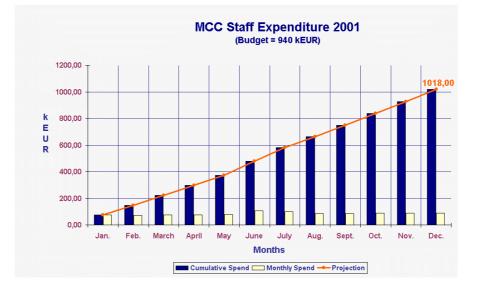

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1 Year 2001 MCC Expenditure

1.1 MCC Staff Expenditure (Officers and Assistants)



The chart given above shows the year 2001 expenditure on MCC staff (ie permanently employed ETSI Secretariat Staff). The staff complement has not changed throughout this year and remains as 4 Support Officers, 5 Assistants, and one Department Head as follows:

There has been a slight increase in staff cost due to contractual seniority rises which have led to a small year end overspend. These figures also include the cost of annual leave entitlement that has not been taken during 2002 due to workload conditions. The year expenditure closed at 1018 kEUR against a budget of 940 kEUR.

It should be noted that the total expenditure includes 22kEUR of resource used to support non-3GPP tasks and that the total year end Staff expenditure for 3GPP related tasks, is therefore 996 kEUR.

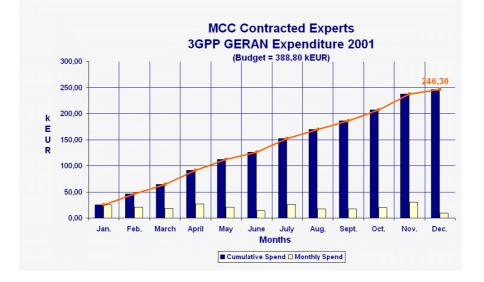
1.2.3.1 3GPP (RAN, CN, T, SA)

1.3 MCC Travel and Subsistence



This chart shows the travel and subsistence expenditure for MCC. It can be seen that the year end expenditure closed as 782 kEUR against a budget of 800 kEUR. MCC has undertaken a total of 233 travels (103 European, and 130 Intercontinental). A detailed breakdown of the travels incurred is available if required, but is considered to be too detailed for this report.

It should be noted that the 2001 budget contained a provision of 19 kEUR for travel associated with non-3GPP tasks and that this leads to a year end travel expenditure for 3GPP related activities of 763 kEUR.

3.3 A5/3 Algorithm Development (Task S18)

Task S18 is the development of a new GSM algorithm to replace A5/2. It will be largely based on the Kasumi core used for the 3G algorithm. The development cost will be shared equally by ETSI, Committee T1 and the GSM Association. 84,66 kEUR has been allocated from the year 2001 contingency for this activity. The work has not yet started but it is expected that the work will be completed during 2002 and within the prescribed budget.
