The 3rd Generation Partnership Project (3GPP) was launched in December 1998. The collaboration agreement brought together a number of telecommunications standards bodies which are known as "Organizational Partners" and the current organizational partners include ARIB, CWTS, ETSI, T1, TTA, and TTC.

Before 3GPP was established, the OPs agreed about the calculation formula for 3GPP contribution in Geneva, October 1999. Since 1999, each OP has collected contribution from its IMs and forwarded it to 3GPP.

The contribution is composed of equal division and proportional division of support budget. The ratio of equal division and proportional division has been set at 50 to 50. As a result of applying this system for the past 3 years, the OPs who have a small number of IMs have been left in a disadvantageous position compared with the bigger OPs.

Based on the current calculation method that the contribution of an OP is divided by the number of its IMs, IMs under a small OP are bound to pay 4 or 5 times as much contribution as IMs under a bigger one. In addition, a comparison between the funding models of 3GPP and 3GPP2 shows that the latter scheme effectively reduces the gap among IMs. (See Attachment 1)

Consequently, many complaints have been raised by the IMs who belong to a small OP and furthermore, some members of small OPs had transferred their allegiance from one OP to another which is believed to impose a lower financial burden on them. In the mean time, some OPs have suffered a decline in membership (See Attachment 2) and it was argued that this had led to an imbalance which could ultimately lead to the collapse of the Project.

Moreover, as we are all aware, the global IT business has been struggling with the continuous recession, not likely to be recovered within a short period of time. To make matters worse, the 3rd generation mobile service, considered a key to the recovery, is being postponed at the moment.

Therefore, to help improve the current funding and financing model of 3GPP, TTA proposes;

- To consider a new calculation formula for 3GPP contribution; Change the ratio of equal division of support budget and proportional division of support budget as 20 to 80.
- To diversify financial sources; Collect contribution from MRPs as well as OPs.
