Information

This report provides detailed information on financial matters concerning the Mobile Competence Centre for year 2002. For completeness and understanding, it contains information relating to the support provided to 3GPP as well as the support provided by MCC to other non-3GPP related bodies.

The figures used throughout this report are based on those available on 22 February 2003.

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1 Year 2002 MCC Expenditure



1.1 MCC Staff Expenditure (Officers and Assistants)

The chart given above shows the year 2002 expenditure for MCC staff (i.e. the permanently employed ETSI Secretariat Staff employed within the Mobile Competence Centre). The staff complement has not changed throughout this year and remains as 4 Support Officers, 5 Assistants, and one Department Head as follows:

David BOSWARTHICK, John MEREDITH, Maurice POPE, Adrian ZOICAS, Marlène FORINA, Karen HUGHES, Susanna KOOISTRA, Florence RAVOIRE, Emmanuelle WURFFEL, Adrian SCRASE

It should be noted that:

- i) One staff member (Susanna Kooistra) has been on maternity leave for part of this period but no replacement has been sought for her. She is due to return to work in March 2003.
- ii) Emmanuelle Wurffel has worked part of her time for an activity that is outside of MCC. The value of the days used for that purpose have been deducted from the year end expenditure figures.

The total year end expenditure for this budget line is **1005 kEUR** (including 35kEUR for non-3GPP related activities) against a budget of **990 kEUR**.

The slight overspend is a result of unused holiday allocation (which represents a financial liability), increased social charges and contractual seniority payments.

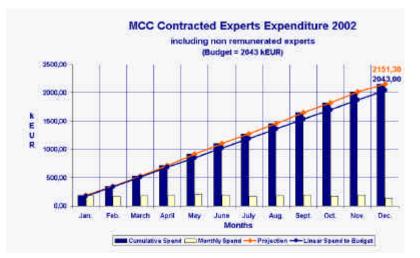
1.1.1 Additional Staff

An additional budget line had been included in the 2002 budget entitled "Additional Staff" to represent the full time employment of Shicheng Hu for the management of TTCN development within MCC. (Shicheng Hu is part of another ETSI Secretariat Department but currently works full time on MCC matters). The year end expenditure for this additional budget line is **145 kEUR** against a budget of **144 kEUR**.

The slight overspend is explained by the number of new contractors that arrived during the year and the need for them to undergo training. This was achieved by periods of parallel working which of course had an associated cost.

From the allocated funding (250 kEUR), a total amount of **216 kEUR** (45 + 171) has been contracted.

Following a discussion in SA WG4, and subsequent discussion within the PCG/OP it was decided to carry forward the unused money and to use it for partial funding of the "Performance Characterisation of default Codecs for Packet Switched conversational multimedia applications" (subject to approval of the contributors). See section 3.3 below for further details.

3.2 A5/3 Algorithm Development (Task S18)

Task S18 was for the development of a new GSM algorithm to replace A5/2. It was agreed that the development cost would be shared equally by ETSI, Committee T1 and the GSM Association. It was initially expected that the task would require **127 kEUR** but due to the addition of a further task (Milenage for 2G) the resulting cost was **143,4 kEUR** as indicated in the table below.

3.3 Performance Characterisation of default Codecs for Packet Switched conversational multimedia applications

The PCG/OP agreed the funding of a new task for the "Performance Characterisation of default Codecs for Packet Switched conversational multimedia applications". The exact funding requirements were not clear but initial funding of **160 kEUR** was allocated from the 2002 contingency.
