2.1 Main events since last meeting

RAN#3: April 21-23 at Shin-Yokohama, Japan

2.2 Major results achieved during this period

- WG1: Most documents are in Ver2.x.y status

Works are generally on schedule

- WG2: Three documents are approved. They are now Ver3.x.y.

Works are on schedule.

- WG3: Ten documents regarding transport protocols are approved.

Works are generally on schedule.

- WG4: FDD RF parameters documents became Ver2.0.0

Other documents are Ver 1.x.y or Ver 0.x.y

2.3 Major problems encountered and how they were solved (if solved)

WG3 requested decision to RAN plenary on Iur protocol architecture, CTP/IP or SS7, since they could not come to the consensus in WG3 meeting. In RAN#4, consensus was obtained to adopt both protocol as option.

ITU-R issue;

ITU-R will refer to 3GPP specifications

Deadline is October'99, documents must be stable and approved

Copyright transfer requested: PCG matter (Separate contribution)

TSG-RAN reviewed the workplan:

Most of them are in line with ITU-R deadline

TDD RF parameter workplan was changed (Very tight schedule)

Lower chip rate on TDD proposed from China was discussed regarding ITU deadline, but RAN could not discuss in detail
