1. Introduction

As is written in the Partnership Project Description, specifications based on national/regional requirements should be also included in technical specifications so that all the SDOs and users recognize national/regional variations in the specifications. Based on this concept, ARIB sometimes have asked to add its national variations by the form of the special note and others.

2. Discussion

By now, most of the variations asked by ARIB are very specific, such as radio performance. However, we think that the very different cases would happen from now on, such as the variation related specific capabilities and function. We believe that in those cases, we should handle the issues basically by the same manner. We also anticipate that this would happen mostly in TSG-RAN.

3. Request

ARIB request all the members' cooperation for the inclusion of variation based on national/regional requirements so that we can keep the same specifications.
