The growing number of mobile networks could justify the ITU maintaining a list of MNC; for this purpose, it would be necessary to trigger appropriate actions in ITU-T SG 2 (a proposal in this sense has been made during the Q.1/2 meeting (Geneva, 4-8.2.02) - final decision can only be taken by the forthcoming SG2 meeting (Geneva, 7-17.5.02).
