We recognize that the scheduling mechanism developed in RAN WG2 has grown into a complex and option loaded scheme compared to the mechanisms initially considered in the EUL study item phase. We note that no or little system evaluation has been provided in support of some of the options recently introduced.

Consequently, we welcome the operator document in RP-050129 on simplifying the Enhanced Uplink scheduling modes, and we propose that TSG RAN guides RAN WG2 to remove the so called "non RG" mode from the scheduling mechanism and strongly encourages RAN WG2 to finalize the details of the scheduling mechanism in its April meeting so that RAN WG1 and RAN WG4 have the opportunity to review the agreed scheme before the June plenary meeting.
