
The underground car park is free of charge!


Meeting Access Control

To Process your badge


Registration & Badge Please register on the 3GPP Portal (same process as usual) The confirmation email will contain the usual token as well as a QR code Delegates already registered do not need to register again *While entering the meeting venue please make sure that you have your QR code available (either on paper or on your mobile phone) *Please scan your QR code on the self-printing desk. *Your badge will be printed (one badge for all the groups) Please wear your badge all week *to be done only the first day




"Centre Commercial Blagnac" (<u>https://blagnac.klepierre.fr/</u>): supermarket, cafeteria, Subway, Starbucks...

It is so French...

- EU power plug: If you do not have a power plug, you can get one at airport shops.
- If you are driving in Toulouse, please be indulgent with the French Drivers!
- Opening hours of shops: 10:00-19:00

It is so Toulouse...

- "CHOCOLATINE" for pain au chocolat
- TOULOUSE VIOLET Sample the delicate flavour of Toulouse violets. While the flower and its
 colour are emblematic of the city, it also enhances desserts or can be eaten crystallised, like a
 sweet. Discover it at the Maison de la Violette barge moored on the Canal du Midi and in the
 specialist shops Violettes et Pastels and Trésors de Violette. amaisondelaviolette.com
- FÉNÉTRA Fénétra is a pastry made with shortbread dough, a compote of apricots and confit lemons, topped with a soft almond biscuit. Its origins date back to ancient times. Every year, the Romans honoured their dead in the suburb of Fénétra, to the south of the city, where there was a necropolis. In the Middle Ages, the pagan rite became a religious ceremony held during Lent. Then, in the 17th century, it took the form of a feast during which the cake was served. All the best places to try it. legateaudufenetra.comstresorsdeviolette.com
- CASSOULET Toulouse cassoulet is a hearty dish of white beans, duck and Toulouse sausage, simmered in a cassole (an earthenware dish whose name is derived from the Occitan caçolet). Where can you find this?
 Fresh or tinned (Samaran, La conserverie du Lauragais, Maison Cucq...)
 On the menu at restaurants such as Émile, Le Colombier, Chez Moustache and Le Bibent, as well as at Genty Magre (awarded the prize for the best cassoulet in the world in 2023). And why not try févoulet, a variation of cassoulet made with broad beans (at Point d'Ogre).
