1. NA2/NAR notes your liaison from your meeting Sophia Antipolis, 25-26 February 1999
2. We ask you to note that NA2/NAR is the recognised liaison point on IMT2000 numbering and routeing issues with ITU-T Study Group2
3. To date discussions within NA2/NAR with regard to future naming and addressing (numbering) requirements for UMTS have been relatively inconclusive. However, the Group has agreed that there should be no limit on the use of alpha, alpha-numeric or numeric characters for the composition of future names for use with UMTS.
4. This has resulted in an agreement that future signalling capabilities should cater for alpha, alpha-numeric and numeric forms. This was combined with the view that any signalling development would be applicable to both the wireless and wireline technologies.
5. NA2/NAR has agreed to a new work item on "Naming" which may be applicable to UMTS. We will keep you advised of progress in this area
6. We should be grateful if you would continue to liaise with us on any UMTS naming and addressing matters.
