SA Info/Guidance Requested

- TrFO break solution (Two solutions)
 - Monitoring when needed
 - RFCI Interrogation
 - Delay in selecting solution may push completion date beyond March, 2001.
 - RAN3 input desperately needed as they are primarily affected by the solutions.

Resolution of Issues from SA#8

- GEA2 Ciphering
 - CRs approved for R97/R98
 - Interworking issues in introducing GEA2 in mixed R97/R98 and R99 networks
- Removal of Service Accept Message
 - Compromise reached in Seattle CN1/SA2 joint meeting
 - CRs to 24.008 conditionally approved
- Hexadecimal IMEI
 - No action taken
- Terminology
 - Agreed to use A/Gb mode and Iu mode for R'99
 - Further study for R'00 terminology

CN Organization for IM Subsystem Work

- Allocation of IM work to WGs by protocol
 - CN1: SIP (Call control) including SIP supplementary services, SDP (Session Definition Protocol)
 - CN2: CAMEL extensions for VoIP and multimedia
 - CN3: QoS protocols (such as RSVP), RTP (CRPT should probably be in RAN3).
 - CN4: Name to Address translation functions, AAA protocols, security protocols, subscriber data management in HSS and the HSS to CSCF protocols to support this.
 - CN5: extension of OSA to VoIP and multimedia
- Joint CN meetings during first half of 2001.

R'00 Release Principles Endorsed by CN

- Decoupling of standards releases (versions of the standards) from the year on year deliverable approach;
- Stages 2 and 3 of the IP Multimedia Subsystem are included in the same release of the specifications (Currently UE-CSCF SIP stage 3 is scheduled for completion by Dec 01);
- There is no priority or precedence given to Release 4 over Release 5 when working the feature in the working groups. Generally, for future parallel working releases there should be no priority or precedence given to one release over another.
