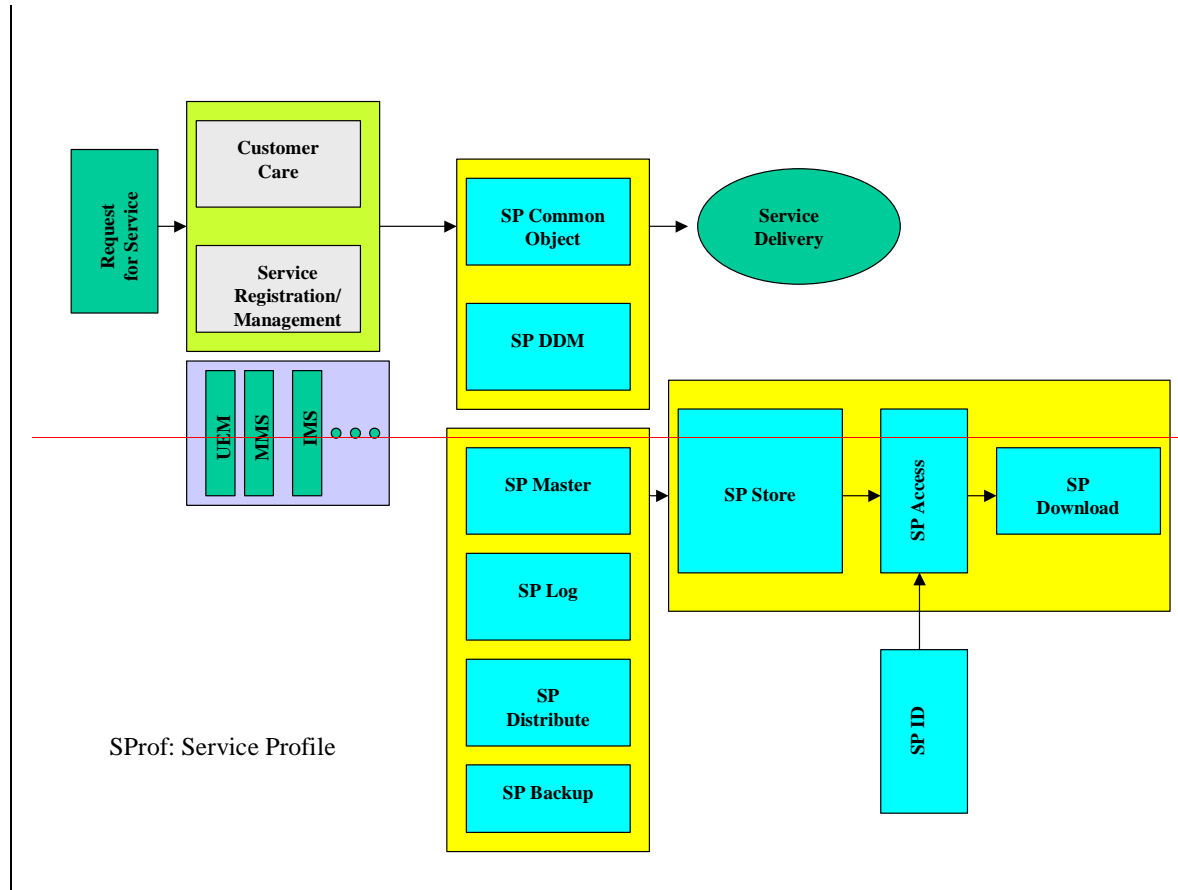

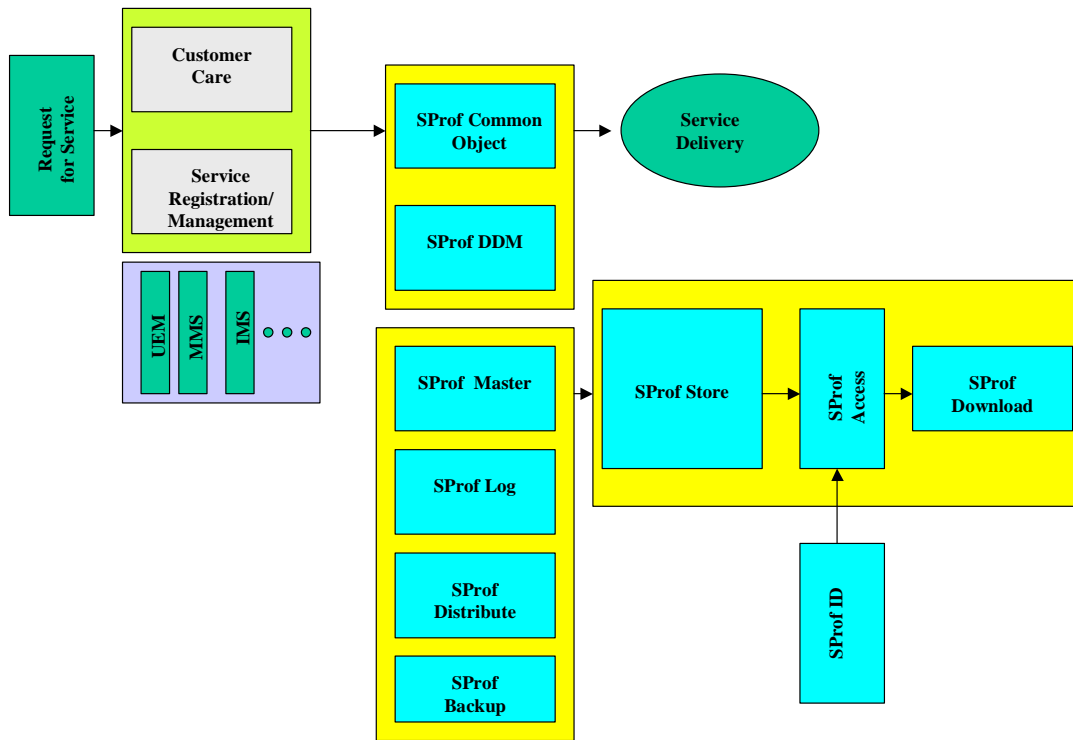


Figure 3: Architecture for management of Subscription Profile components
