**1. Overall Description:**

SA2 has been considering the security implications of SA3's LS in S3-030303 and have been discussing potential mechanisms to resolve the security issue as requested in the LS. These mechanisms have included terminal-only based methods and network-only based methods. However, no decision could be reached due to the various shortcomings that arise from each of the methods discussed.

Therefore, SA2 are unable to inform SA3 about the possible mechanisms to solve the security issue.

It was generally agreed in SA2 that it is SA3's role to select a suitable mechanism that would address the security implications.
