

Report on GAA evening session, October 9, 2003

1. Draft TS, Generic Authentication Architecture (GAA);

Support for Subscriber Certificates

The new draft TS was provided by Nokia. It was **agreed** that the Support for subscriber related parts should be moved from the existing SSC TS to the new TS as is. A CR can be created to move relevant parts of the text from the informative annex to the main body.

2. Draft TS, Generic Authentication Architecture (GAA);

Generic Bootstrapping Architecture

The new draft TS was provided by Nokia. The new draft TS was **agreed** by the evening session.

3. Draft TS, HTTPS

Nokia, Siemens and Ericsson provided drafts for this TS. The Presence TS was also discussed in this context.

It was agreed that the Presence TS should be the basis for work in release 6. For the HTTPS TS, a table of contents will be provided. Further work on the HTTPS TS would be done for future releases.

Note: this means that all the other TSEs (SSC, GBA) and the GAA TR should be ready for release 6.

It was agreed that Tao and Krister agree on the content of S3-030524, draft TS for Presence, v 0.1.0.

It was agreed to discuss on the table of contents Friday morning.

4. GAA TR

This was provided for information. It was agreed to take a look at the draft and provide comments offline to Annelies.
