FROM THE AIRPORT TO THE SIEMENS PREMISES OR THE NOVOTEL HOTEL

by taxi:

The trip will cost about 45 EURO and will take about 45 min under normal traffic conditions.

by train/underground:

Take S-Bahn (suburban train) line S8 from the airport to Ostbahnhof (30 min). At Ostbahnhof, change to underground line U5 to Neuperlach-Sued (10 min).

At Neuperlach-Sued station, take the front exit to the Siemens premises, take the rear exit to the Novotel hotel. The hotel is located at the intersection of Rudolf-Vogel-Bogen and Carl-Wery-Strasse (marked by a dot on the attached map mchp3.gif).

MEETING VENUE

The address of the meeting venue is:

Siemens AG, Otto-Hahn-Ring 6, 81739 Muenchen, Germany

The meeting will be held in the Siemens Training Center / Xenia Forum, building no. 48, room 243 (on the ground floor), see attached map mch_p.gif.

(For those who attended SA3#25: the meeting room is NOT in the same building as for SA3#25.)

The easiest way to find the meeting room from the Novotel hotel or the train station is to walk all around the Siemens premises counter clock-wise (i.e. with the Siemens buildings to your left), following the signs "Siemens Training Center / Xenia Forum". (From the hotel, it is a bit of a walk, though.) There is an entrance to the premises near building 48.

If you stay in the Novotel you may instead want to use the north entrance to the premises (near building 12, see map). Ring a bell at the door to be let into building 48.
