Free transport pass



Transport pass

- Transport passes will be offered to delegates free of charge:
 - courtesy of Toulouse Métropole
 - free public transport during the event (tram, subway, bus, airport shuttle)



How to get your transport pass?

<u>Delegates travelling by plane can retrieve passes at a booth after luggage</u> <u>claim: **exit 4 Hall D** (international exit). If your exit is national e.g. number 2 there will be a sign to direct you to exit 4.</u>

Registration to your WGs is mandatory: You will get your free transport pass ONLY IF YOU ARE REGISTERED BY THURSDAY 10 NOVEMBER. The staff at the airport does not know you, therefore they will only give the pass to a person who is on the participant list of your WG that you will attend during the week.

Opening hours = Sunday 08am to 8pm



How to get your transport pass?

Passes will also be available at the hospitality desk of the MEETT from Monday morning.

Again, only for Delegates registered!

Passes will be given in person.






General map

Coming to MEETT by tram

- MEETT is on tram line T1
- Stop: "Station MEETT"
- ▼Timetable: https://www.tisseo.fr/sites/default/files/fh/Tisseo_ligne_T1web.pdf

- Free of charge using transport pass, single ticket: 1.70 euros otherwise
- From downtown Toulouse: subway (A line to "Arênes" stop or B line to "Palais de justice"), then tram (T1 line) to MEETT, 45-60 minutes



Coming to MEETT by bus

- Stop: "MEETT Beauzelle"
- ▼Timetable: https://www.tisseo.fr/sites/default/files/fh/Tisseo_ligne_30web.pdf
- Free of charge using transport pass, single ticket: 1.70-2 euros otherwise
- From airport: bus (line 30) to "MEETT Beauzelle", 15-20 minutes depending on traffic



Coming to the MEETT by coach?

- There will be no private coaches.
- - The hotel booking platform was not used much: only 400 rooms booked from a total of 2000.
 - Therefore, we had no visibility for organizing the pick-up.
- But you can organise/book your own bus:
 - 8 seats = 165€, 20 seats = 275€, 40-50 seats = 385€ tax included (price per ride)

Coming to the MEETT by car

- Address: MEETT, Concorde Avenue, 31840 Aussonne (follow "parking" signs)
- Parking lot capacity of 3000 spots (price list on next slide)

≈25-40 minutes from downtown Toulouse, depending on traffic

The MEET






- The MEET has been privatized: only 3GPP Delegates

The full structure

- Access from right side
- Walk through the Rue Centrale
- Security check outside before 3GPP area.
- Go to 3GPP meeting area





- There will be security checks (with visual inspections of bags) at the entrance of the convention centre every day.
- Upon arrival, delegates can get their badge printed

Registration & Badge

- Please register on the 3GPP Portal (same process as usual)
- The confirmation email will the usual token as well as a QR code
- Delegates already registered do not need to register again
- An updated confirmation email will be sent beg. of November
- *While entering the MEETT please make sure that you have your QR code available (either on paper or on your mobile phone)
- *Please scan your QR code on the self-printing desk
- *Your badge will be printed (one badge for all the groups)
- Please wear your badge all week




Self-printing desk on-site




How to convert your registration to a paper 36

badge?





Your access to the meeting room

- ✓ Your badge will be scanned in front of the 15 main meeting rooms every morning.
- Scanning will serve as an experimental check-in for the meeting
- Check-in information from badge scanning will be synchronized to 3GPP portal every 10 minutes
- This process is just a TEST, that's why the entrance of the main WGs doors will only be checked every morning.
- In parallel of this test, please check in with your token.
- The check-ins from tokens will be synchronized only at the end of the week.



Audio system

Overview

- We will be using an infrared audio system instead of loudspeakers in meeting rooms, making Toulouse a 'silent meeting'
- All delegates will be provided with:
 - An I/R receiver (same type of devices used for audio guides in museums), and
 - A pair of earbuds that can be kept as a souvenir (only one pair per person, please!).

Note: delegates can also use their own headphones or earbuds using a jack 3.5mm connector (Bluetooth not supported).



IMPORTANT: receivers shall be returned at the end of the meeting week!!



Listening

- I/R receivers are multi-channels and can be used in all meeting rooms → no need to pick one for every meeting!
- All a delegate needs to do is to select the appropriate channel to listen to the meeting.
 - A channel guide will be provided by the meeting start.
- Audio of all CT and SA rooms will be broadcast in all CT and SA rooms, and audio of all RAN rooms will be broadcast in all RAN rooms.



Speaking

- In meeting rooms, setup is as usual from a microphone's perspective:
 - Microphone on the top table of each meeting room for sessions chairs
 - Stand up microphones in meeting rooms for delegates



Distribution of I/R receivers

- ▼I/R receivers along with earbuds will be available by the hospitality desk during the week.
- ☼ Delegates can keep the receivers with them all week long, no need to return them every night.
- Battery life should be sufficient for the entire meeting duration.
- ➣In case of problems, receivers can be swapped with new ones.

Again: receivers shall be returned at the end of the meeting week!!



Remote participation

- Remote participation will be offered in the meetings rooms using Gotomeeting, Gotowebinar or Microsoft Teams.
- Two-way audio: remote participants will be able to listen to the meeting and speak using their computer or phone.
- F2F participants should not use the conferencing tools!


Meeting rooms floor plan GROUND FLOOR




Outside of MEETT: car/tram only


Shopping mall
