


Hotel Booking Information

Reservation Cut-off Dates

The group rates are available until the dates indicated in the table above, or until the block is sold out. Rates are anticipated to be significantly higher after the cut-off date or once the room block is fully booked.

Hotel Reservation Cancellations

Reservations must be cancelled **no later than 7 days prior to scheduled arrival** to avoid the penalty of one night's room fee plus tax.

Weather

The weather in Calgary in mid-November is typically cold, breezy, and overcast. Heavy snowfall is not common in Calgary at this time of year. Rain is possible. Daily temperatures average at 38°F, or 3°C. Layers are recommended.

Airport

The Calgary International Airport is 20 km (12 miles) from the BMO Centre, where all WG meetings will take place.

Ground Transportation

Line 300 Bus – 59 minutes, \$4 Lyft and Uber are available and recommended

VISA APPLICATION GUIDANCE FOR CANADA MEETINGS

1. Be Informed

Attached, you will find a letter containing critical information for your visa application process to Canada. We urge you to carefully review all the information and procedures for non-immigrant visa applications provided by Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC). Please read the attached letter in its entirety. It includes information regarding application types, processing times, and a step-by-step demonstration of how to submit your application package. Canadian visa policy permits citizens of certain countries to travel to the Canada without a visa. For information about whether you may require a visa, please find such information at the following location online:

Please remember that your application must be submitted through the Canadian Embassy or Consulate General, which has jurisdiction over your place of residence. 2. Register for the Meetings via 3GPP

As a visa applicant, it is **required** that you first register for the Working Group Meetings via the <u>3GPP Online Portal</u>. If you do not complete this step, you will not be able to request a visa letter from ATIS or complete your application package. The Canadian government and the IRCC require all applicants be recorded as registered for the meetings in order for their visa application to be approved.

3. Submit a Request for a Visa Letter via ATIS

Once you have registered via the 3GPP Portal for the Working Group Meetings, please submit a request for a visa letter via this link: https://atis.org/calgary-visa-requests/.

Included in your visa letter will be a Special Event Code, issued by the IRCC to identify registered participants of the 2026 WG Meetings. This is intended to help streamline the Canadian visa application process.

In order to properly process your visa application, ATIS must obtain the following information for the IRCC:

- Date of Birth
- Passport Number, Issuing Country, and Expiration Date

After you enter your personal information, the completed form will be automatically processed. Signed letters will be returned via email. The invitation letter cannot be completed without including your hotel information and confirmation number. Letters may take up to 14 working days to be processed. Please note that after October 15, 2026, hard copies of the invitation letter will not be physically sent. They will only be sent via email.

If you have not received your letter within 14 working days or have any changes or questions after receiving your email, please contact Jo Seibel at visas@atis.org.

Alternatively, Calgary visa invitation letters can be picked up in Dallas from Tuesday, November 18 at 9:00 a.m. until Thursday, November 20 at 7:00 p.m. during the 2025 meetings. Your application must be completed by Thursday, November 14, 2025, to personally pick up your visa invitation letter onsite at the Dallas WG meetings. Please be sure to check the correct box indicating you will pick up your letter in Dallas.

Alternatively, Calgary visa letters can also be picked up in Baltimore from Monday, December 8 at 9:00 a.m. until Thursday, December 11 at 7:00 p.m. during the December TSGs.


4. Compile Application Materials and Submit Application Package to IRCC Utilizing the resources given above in Step 1, compile your application materials and submit your application package to the IRCC.

5. Supply Visa Application Number to ATIS

Upon the beginning of the processing of your visa application, the IRCC will provide you with a Visa Application Number. Please immediately send this number to Jo Seibel at visas@atis.org, along with your full name and company. The IRCC requires that ATIS provide registered visa applicants' Visa Application Number for security and processing purposes. Failure to submit this information back to ATIS may result in a processing delay or cancellation of your visa application.
