ITU-T Q.2/13 thanks SG 3, SG 4, 3GPP SA5, ETSI TISPAN WG 2, and ATIS TMOC for the cooperation efforts with us about charging and accounting in NGN, especially all the detailed inputs via liaison statements to the April SG 13 meeting. During our April meeting, we considered your liaison statements and we incorporated the substance of your inputs.

Thanks to your constructive inputs, we believe that all issues in our Y.ngn-account draft Recommendation have been now resolved with the exception of two, as indicated in the first page of the attached Y.ngn-account document.

Although the draft Recommendation was significantly enhanced in this meeting, there was consensus on postponing the request for consent of Y.ngn-account, originally planned for this SG 13 meeting, to next September NGN GSI event, mainly in order to allow feedback from members about the various modifications agreed at this meeting and to receive contributions towards closure of the two remaining open issues.

We invite you to review our latest version of Y.ngn-account, and welcome your comments, in particular on the two remaining open issues.
