- P4 verified TCs: 82%
  - Current approved P4 TC: 77%
- FDD TTCN deliveries in 2004
  - 4 formal deliveries + 17 T1 interim working deliveries
- Publication of weekly TTCN approval status, CR tracking list and TC reservation lists
  - 1200 TTCN CRs + comments uploaded, tracked & controlled this year
    - Category B: 950, category F: 250
- Nearly 200 LCR TDD TCs drafted



### **GERAN TTCN approval**



- Another 4 TCs in the approval queue
  - To be approved on 16th Dec.
- 82% of P4 approval (UTRAN + GERAN) will be reached
- The e-mail approved TCs are to be forwarded to GERAN#23 for formal approval
- 51.010-5 v6.0.0 has been created by GERAN
  - to contain GERAN/ UTRAN TCs approved











- 2 CCSA / TDIA experts worked at ETSI
- 197 TCs have been derived from FDD

- P1: 75 TCs

- P2: 51 TCs

- P3: 46 TCs

- P4: 25 TCs

Baseline Rel-4, March 03











- Baseline moving from "R99 March 03" to "Rel-5 Dec 04" for R99 stream
  - Transition period, March May 05, for WI-10 & 12 (R99 interoperability test)
  - Two baselines maintained at this period
  - Intensive regression tests on the two baselines will be needed
- Baseline "Rel-5 Dec 04" for Rel-5 stream starting in March for GCF WI- 13 (Enhancement), & WI-14 (HSDPA)
  - Essential for HSDPA test
- Two work streams on single baseline "Rel-5 Dec. 04" (ref. TP-040232, slide 7)
  - Starting date: 1<sup>st</sup> June 2005
  - R99 stream for GCF WI-10 &12
  - Rel-5 stream for GCF WI-13 & WI-14
  - On single ASN.1 module of "Rel-5 Dec. 04"







- 95% of GCF R99 WI-10 & 12 on R99 baseline
  - 20 May 05
- 95% of R99 WI-10 & 12 on Rel-5 Dec 04 baseline
  - 03 June 05
- 80% of Rel-5 WI 13 & 14 on Rel-5 Dec. 04 baseline
  - 10 Sept 05











- Recently GCF is introducing a new WI-15 for A-GPS test
  - About 30 TCs
  - Baseline R99
  - Request TTCN
- A-GPS will become one of the tasks in 2005
- Funding for A-GPS should be sorted out.
  - Voluntary contributions from the interesting companies can be the solution.















### **LCR TDD 2005**

- TDD continues to complete packages
  - Another 200 TCs for completion
- Decision on the baseline moving to Rel-5 Dec 04 is not yet made
  - Discussions with TDIA are ongoing
  - Proposal will be made at T1#26 (Feb 05)
