I am writing to let you know that Ronin Wireless, an ETSI member, has set up the website [www.mexeforum.org](http://www.mexeforum.org) with the idea that new developments, updates and information concerning MExE could be shared amongst the smaller developer community on the Internet. MExE represents a very exciting new platform which will not reach its full potential without the embrace of the developer community and therefore Ronin Wireless believes that it is essential to provide information to them in an easy-to-read way with appropriate feedback means like discussion fora.

The MExE Forum has already become very popular amongst developers as well as manufacturers, operators and other interested parties. Already over 120 individuals and 30 companies have joined the forum in an effort to obtain information on MExE and participate in an online community.

Ronin Wireless would like to make closer links between this activity and 3GPP, and would like the advice of the PCG on how to go about this. One idea might be to give the MExE Forum a Market Representation Partner status, since the MExE Forum has been set up exclusively to Market the results of the MExE work in T2. However the PCG may have other ideas which would help us gain wider recognition of the 3GPP MExE standards in the developer community.
