Title: Proposed Actions for the OHG Open Letter

1. Introduction

TTC recognizes the importance of the harmonization of the IMT-2000 CDMA air interfaces to achieve global roaming, and really appreciates the OHG (Operator Harmonization group) activities. TTC fully supports the Harmonized Global 3G(G3G) technical framework for IMT-2000 CDMA proposal stated in the attachment of the OHG open letter addressed to Standard Organizations.

TTC urges 3GPP to ensure that the OHG technical framework be adopted and to take appropriate actions as soon as possible.

2. Proposed Actions

The following actions are required for 3GPP to implement the OHG recommendations;

1) Administrative and Procedural Actions

- a) Obtain unanimous support for the OHG recommendations among 3GPP Partners and respond to the OHG letter as soon as possible in a harmonized way.
- b) Review and modify 3GPP Working Procedures including, but not limited to, Scope and objectives and Terms of Reference for each TSG so that TSG can start technical work on defining "Hooks" and "Extensions".
- c) Ensure that both 3GPP and 3GPP2 TSG experts can have joint technical activities.
- d) Arrangements must be made so that 3GPP TSG members can gain access to necessary documents developed by 3GPP2 and vice versa in order to proceed the study.
- e) The ownership of jointly developed specifications (i.e. "Hooks" and "Extensions") need to be clarified. TTC believes that jointly developed "Hooks" should be owned by the specification owner to which "Hooks" are attached. The ownership of jointly developed "Extensions" is for further study.
- f) A new voting system might be required when consensus could not be achieved for defining "Hooks" and "Extensions" among 3GPP TSG and 3GPP2 TSG experts.
- g) A leading party of specifying "Hooks" and "Extension" for each module should be clearly defined in order to avoid confusion.


A leading party shall hold expert meetings and invite non-leading party experts.

TTC believes that establishing new groups may cause overall delay in defining specifications.

2) Technical Actions

- a) A leading 3GPP TSG should be determined for overall technical co-ordination across all concerned TSGs/WGs and 3GPP2 TSGs. The designated TSG should create a work plan as soon as possible. TTC believes that TSG-SA would be an appropriate leading TSG. Any impacts on the current specification schedule should be identified as soon as possible.
- b) "Hooks" and "Extensions" shall be defined in such a way that they shall be able to provide flexibility for the future expansions and improvements.


Proposed Responsibility and Ownership of Specifications (cdma2000 over DS Case)
