Release '97, '98, '99, 4 Status


- CR level on earlier releases is low except for:
 - CAMEL Phase 3 (will tighten CR acceptance criteria)
- M3UA finally approved in IETF
- Removed specs from Rel'99
 - 03.63, 04.63 (PDS)
- Removed specs from Rel 4
 - 23.814 out of date TR on classmark structure
 - 43.063, 44.063 (PDS)

- Most items expected to complete in June 02
- Considerable progress in IMS
- Initial dependencies from IETF approved

- IMS: Call Control in IMS
 - Major open items:
 - Signalling Compression
 - Authentication and Key Transport
 - Integrity Protection
 - P-Headers
 - Plan with IETF to provide necessary deliverables (bundles of RFCs)
 - Bundles 0-1 delivered
 - Bundles 2-3 under negotiation
 - 23.218 completed
 - 24.228 and 24.229 put under change control



- IMS: Access Security for IMS
 - Solution selected based on IPSec
- IMS: End-to-End QoS
 - Decision to use COPS-PR reconfirmed
 - PIB definition underway





- IMS: Interworking IMS <-> CS
 - Interworking Architecture specified
 - Interworking flows specified
 - Parameter mapping NOT specified
 - Awaiting ITU-T references (not completed until Nov 02)
 - ITU-T Q.1912.SIP (SIP to BICC / ISUP interworking)
 - ITU-T Q.2150.3 (SCTP)
 - Interworking with mapping moved to Rel 6
 - Does not preclude interworking



- IMS: OSA interworking
 - Mapping now to ISC (not vanilla SIP)
- IMS: CAMEL interworking
 - Stage 2 for CAMEL control of IMS (23.278) 60% complete
 - Stage 2 for information transfer between HSS & IM-SSF 15% complete.
 - Views in CN are divided on whether this work can be completed by June.



CAMEL Phase 4

- Completed:
 - Interactions with Optimal Routing
 - CAMEL control over MT SMS
 - Provision of location information of called subscriber
 - Inclusion of ODB data in the CSE-HLR interface
 - Inclusion of flexible tone injection: CPH interaction is FFS
- 80% or more complete, expected completion in June:
 - Call Party Handling
 - Notification of GPRS mobility management to CSE
 - Location information during an ongoing call
 - GPRS Any Time Interrogation
 - Mid call procedure for MO and MT calls
- New functionality agreed at SA#15:
 - Transfer of the IMEI (with SW version) to the CSE (60%)
 - Functional Subsetting (CN2 to study, no problems expected)



OSA Enhancements

- Framework : 65 % (SA3 dialogue)
- Generic User Interaction: 65 %
- Charging: 95% (work ready, CR in 06/2002)
- Policy Management : 95% (work ready, CR in 06/2002)
- Presence & Availability Management : 90% (work ready subset for 3GPP needs still to be created and reviewed, CR in 06/2002)
- Call Control mapping to ISC: 70%
- WSDL APIs for HTTP/SOAP transport : 90% (automatic mapping rules from UML created, WSDL APIs generated, CRs need to be produced)
- Journaling: 0%, clarification from SA1 requested
- Retrieval of Network Capabilities : 10%, clarification from SA1 pending



- WB-AMR (CN Aspects)
 - Open issues:
 - Codec selection and GSM-UTRAN interworking almost completed (June 2002)
 - TFO and TrFO signalling almost completed (June 2002)
 - Lawful interception on-going, pending on SA3-LI work (June 2002)
- Service Change and UDI Fallback
 - Open issues:
 - Interworking with ISUP (requested by SA1) (June 2002)
 - Clarification of handling of pre-99 mobiles (June 2002)



- Security Enhancements
 - Stage 3 for MAP Key Distribution
 - Requirements clarifications needed from SA3
 - Network Domain Security for GTP
 - Requirements clarifications needed from SA3
- Intra Domain Connection of RAN Nodes to Multiple CN Nodes
 - Completed!

 - Does not prevent proprietary interworking solutions
- IMS: Interworking IMS<-> CS
 - Includes parameter mapping
- Presence
 - Simple to develop, based upon IMS
