

Time plan after CT#91

The rapporteur's plan for FS_MINT-CT study is as follows:

Change the plan for MINT

- Revised SID for FS_MINT-CT was approved at CT#91e
 - Revised SID to extend study until June (was March 2021)
 - The tentative time plan was
 - CT1 finishes study by **April** WG meeting, and send an LS to SA/SA2 in April
 - SA2 will assess the result in S2#145 (May) and send an LS to SA/CT1
 - SA will assess the result in TSG#92 (June) and confirm the study
 - CT1 may discuss and approve WID in May meeting, while keep working on KI#5.
 - If the response arrives by June TSG CT, CT can approve WID, or TSG#93 (Sep) can approve
 - 6 months / 9 months normative work (Q4 '21, Q1 '22)
 - 1 more WG meeting for study
 - The progress may be delayed if SA/SA2 cannot conclude in time, still have 6 months at least

Impact of the LSeS to SA1 / SA3

CT1 sent four LSeS to SA1 and SA3 in CT1#128e meeting

- C1-211189: LS on broadcasting from other PLMN in case of Disaster Condition (to SA3)
 - 1) whether receiving and utilizing broadcast information as being studied in TR 24.811 from PLMNs other than the PLMN with Disaster Condition, which can be the home PLMN or a visited PLMN, pose any security risks; and
 - 2) if the answer to Q1 is yes, then what would be SA3's recommendations from security perspective?
- C1-211192: LS on disaster roaming for MINT related to PLMN change (SA1)
 - 1) Can disaster roaming service be provided to the UE in disaster area by the PLMN with DC over 3GPP access?
 - 2) Can disaster roaming service be provided to the UE in disaster area by the PLMN with DC over non-3GPP access?
- C1-211237: LS on HPLMN control of devices that should not use disaster roaming service (SA1)
 - Is there a requirement for the HPLMN to preclude certain UEs from attempting to use disaster roaming service?
- C1-211324: LS on disaster roaming and non-public network hosted by a PLMN (SA1)
 - When a CAG-supporting UE determines that Disaster Condition applies, and a PLMN can provide disaster roaming to the UE, is the UE without CAG configuration for the PLMN allowed to select and register on a CAG cell of the PLMN?



Impact of the LSeS to SA1 / SA3

- Conclusions of each Key issues in TR 24.811 could be affected by the response from SA1 or SA3 to those Lses
- Due to those pending responses from SA1 / SA3, it may not be possible to conclude all the key issues by April CT1 meeting
- The Key Issues without the pending issues are not affected



Result of the moderated discussion

- The interesting companies in CT1 has progressed a kind of informal show-of-hands like process between C1#128 and C1#129, which is so-called “moderated discussion” process (like SA2 or RAN WGs do for their study phase).
- The result or summary of the moderated discussion is described in C1-212334.
