New TSG_CN structure after CN#7

The main reasons for this is proposal are:

- i Clear separation of N2A and N2B
- ii No new SS-activities expected
- iii IP issues currently too pre-mature to be dedicated to the working groups
- iv Huge workload in CAMEL group OSA applies new techniques (CORBA)
- v Project oriented organisation in special areas of CN activities

The lifetime of the N-IP ad hoc activity will depend on the general progress of this "work item". Perhaps this activity can be closed with CN#8 if work is sufficiently clear to be distributed to the working groups.

But until CN#8 the CN working groups will focus on the debugging and completion of R'99 issues.
