## 1. Introduction

The OHG has proposed an All-IP related workshop between 3GPP and 3GPP2. This contribution proposes a scope of the workshop.

## 2. Short term All IP Harmonization

Currently, both 3GPP and 3GPP2 are standardizing All-IP NW (or IMS in 3GPP terminology). The OHG has so far proposed a workshop for the harmonization of two All-IP related standards. However,

- (1) Initial IMS specifications will soon be completed by mid 2002.
- (2) It is not meaningful to harmonize only All-IP part over different NW infrastructure (i.e., GSM evolved CN and ANSI-41 evolved CN).
- (3) Two All-IP related standards have already been fairly harmonized thanks to the effort of some major vendors.

Thus, we cannot expect fruitful discussion or substantial conclusion by dealing with harmonization.

## 3. Proposed Scope




Figure 1  $\,$  An example roadmap to pure All-IP NW

It is without saying that not only mobile network but also all the telecommunication networks will (or should) be evolved All-IP NW in the near future. It's time to start considering a single global standard for such pure All-IP NW. Therefore, we propose to have a scope on "*Roadmap to Pure All-IP NW*" (See Figure 1) in the possible joint workshop between 3GPP and 3GPP2.
