4 Main concepts

The enhanced Multi-Level Precedence and Pre-emption service (eMLPP) provides different levels of precedence for call set-up and for call continuity in case of handover.

There are seven priority levels which are defined in 3G TS 22.067. The two-highest levels (A) is are reserved for network internal use. The second highest level (B) may be used for network internal use or, optionally, depending on regional requirements, for subscription. These two levels (A and B) can-may only be used locally, i.e. in the domain of one MSC. The other five priority levels are offered for subscription and can-may be applied globally, e.g. on inter switch trunks, if supported by all related network elements, and also for interworking with ISDN networks providing the MLPP service.

The seven priority levels are defined as follows:

- A (highest, for network internal use)
- B (for network internal use or, optionally, for subscription)
- 0 (for subscription)
- 1 (for subscription)
- 2 (for subscription)
- 3 (for subscription)
- 4 (lowest, for subscription).
