Curriculum vitae of Michael Färber.

Michael studied Communication Technology at the Engineers Academy of Dieburg, Germany until 1985. He joined Siemens Mobile Networks in 1985. For the next two years, he did RF Hardware Development for the German analog cellular system C450.
