## How to organise studies

The current 3GPP working method presents the following issues

- it adopts a bottom-up approach
- no top down governance and steerage exists
- technical solutions are sometimes not justified by service requirements
- Unnecessary options and complexities are sometimes introduced


The technical solutions of the new developments should be kept consistent with identified requirements with a minimum complexity


#### Group structure for the WCDMA Evolution



### Proposal for RAN

To create an "Ad-hoc group on UTRAN Evolution" that coordinates the work on the Study Item, reporting to the RAN plenary

## **Proposed structure**



#### **Ad-hoc Group on UTRAN Evolution**

- The Ad-hoc group, with its chairperson, reports directly to the RAN plenary in order to coordinate the work, solve inter WGs issues and liaise with other TSGs.
- According to the current rules, the Study Item rapporteur is responsible to report the progress of the work to the RAN plenary (as for the other SIs and WIs)
- In particular, the ad hoc group :
  - translates the general requirements produced by the Toronto workshop in technical requirements that can be passed to the WGs
  - defines a general reference architecture with the relevant interfaces
  - ensures consistency of the WGs developments
  - convenes and chairs joint WGs meetings on evolution
  - verifies that the proposed solutions meet the requirements
  - liaises with other TSGs to ensure the consistency of the overall solution

The Ad-Hoc Group and WGs will have Joint Meetings on the UTRAN evolution issues mainly during RAN WG co-located meetings

- In the first period the Ad-Hoc meets outside WG week (preferably before RAN plenary i.e. the same week)
- Additional meetings when deemed necessary
