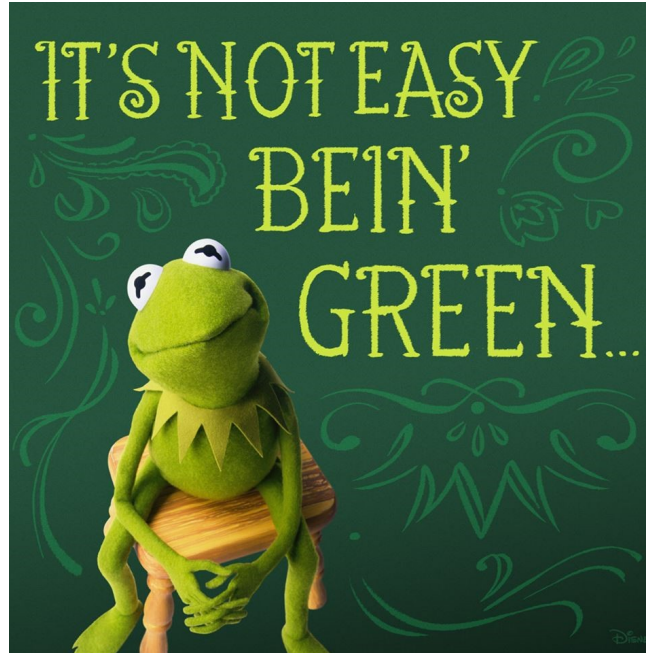

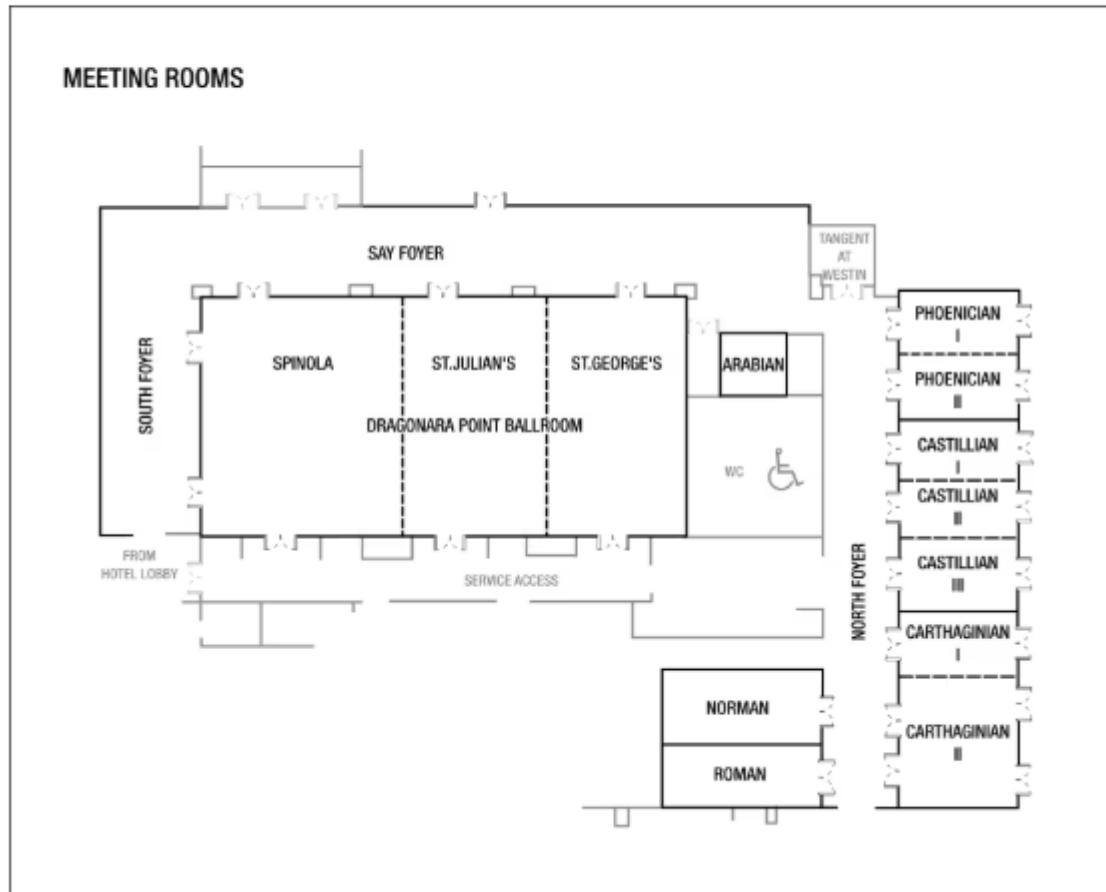

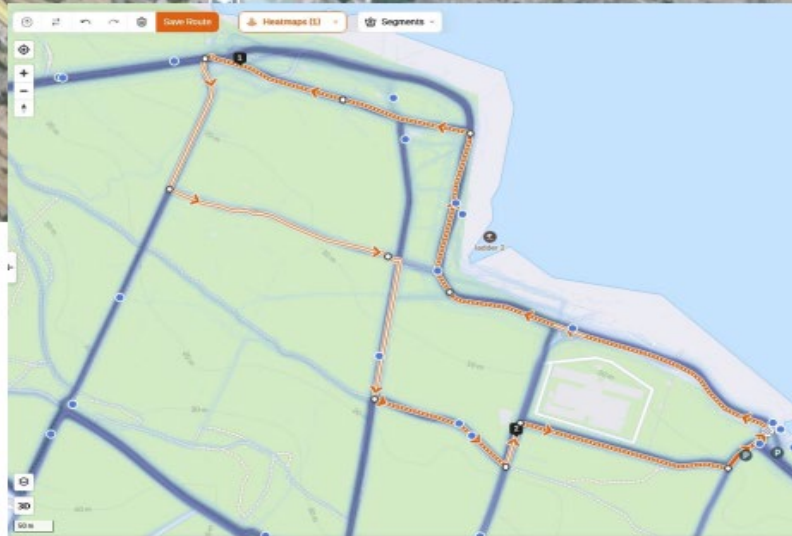

- ✓ **Most recently associated with the United Kingdom**
  - ✓ Unlike other commonwealth countries, in 1956, Malta wanted to rejoin the UK!!
- ✓ **English is commonly spoken by nearly all Maltese nationals**
  - ✓ Maltese language is the local language and is similar to a mix of Italian, Arabic and English!
- ✓ **Maltese culture also highly correlated to Catholic Church, each village has it's own 'feast' and takes great pride in local churches**

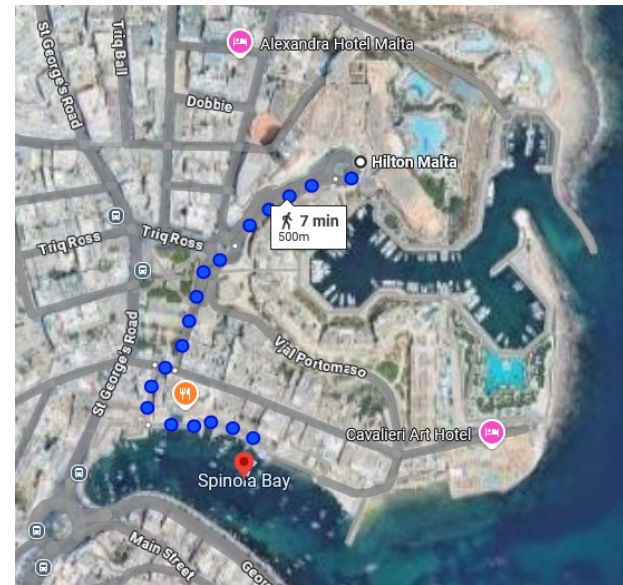
