Title: Regional requirement on FDD base station classes

Introduction

Under a Work Item of "FDD base station classification (WID: RInImp-BSClass-FDD)", technical discussions have been made in RAN-WG4, and a good progress has been made. While its completion date was set to March 2003, ETSI MSG raised a concern and would make a proposal to RAN to approve relevant CRs to produce release 6 specifications in December (RAN#18) $\Box 1 \Box$. Before RAN produces these release 6 specifications with FDD base station classes, ARIB would like to propose to introduce a new "regional requirement" which declares those newly introduced BS classes (i.e. Medium Range BS, Local Area BS) will not be applied in Japan because currently the corresponding regulations do not incorporate them.

Proposed way forward

Introduction of a new regional requirement to TS25.104 and TS25.141 as attached in annex is proposed. Corresponding CRs will be provided at an opportune time to discuss.
