He joined the Nokia Research Center in 1994, where he was involved with W-CDMA system studies. In September 1995, he joined the ACTS FRAMES project being then in the later phase of the project as team leader for the work package which resulted for the FMA2 W-CDMA concept.

During 1997, he was working at the Radio Communications laboratory at Nokia Research Center as a Senior Research Engineer and CDMA Specialist participating in the ETSI SMG2 UMTS standardization work. In SMG2, he worked as a Secretary for the ETSI SMG2 W-CDMA concept group.

Currently he is working at Nokia Telecommunications, Radio Access Systems, WCDMA as Standardisation Manager with UTRA air interface standardisation process in 3GPP. Within ETSI he has been working as Chairman for the UMTS physical layer expert group in 1998 and 1999.
