Task 2: Assessment of Next Generation Devices

- Devices for 3G will be split into two major categories:
 - Voice Centric-Wireless Intelligent Terminals (WITs)
 - Data Centric-Notebooks, Handhelds, Compucators
- Technology Enablers
 - Network: increase in bandwidth, throughput, coverage
 - Applications: ROI for business, convenience for consumers
 - Devices: lower cost, digital, high speed, compact, increased memory
 - Standards: WAP, MNC, IP, Bluetooth
- Market Enablers
 - Use of Internet
 - Technology ownership: computers, wireless phones
 - Use of SIM/smart cards, PC Cards

Task 3: Development of a Business Planning Model

- The Yankee Group will develop a generic PCS/Cellular average revenue per user business model
 - New revenue segments will focus on the following areas:


