Reason for change:	⌘ SA4 have been working on streaming and has defined a basic streaming service for R'4 which is restricted to download streaming. T2 has defined MMS support for streaming in accordance with the relevant SA4 specs. As such MMS R'4 is restricted to supporting streaming download only. This CR aligns the MMS paragraph with the R'4 work done in T2 and SA4.

6.2.2 Multimedia Messaging Service (MMS)

The following basic requirements ~~3GPP TS~~ are to be supported for MMS:

- Store-and-forward multimedia messaging service with mobile and non-mobile users [25].
- MMS shall be capable of supporting integration of different types of messaging (e.g. fax, SMS, Multimedia, voicemail, e-mail etc.) in a consistent manner.
- Streamed (download only) and batch delivery ~~of for both messages, download from the network to the terminal, and messages upload from the terminal to the network.~~
