6 Specifications and Reports

Specifications in the range 01₇.xx to 13.xx are 'pure' GSM specs - that is, those only required to build systems which are based on 3GPP specifications and which use a GSM/EDGE Radio Access Network (GERAN). Those-Specifications in the range 21.xxx to 35.xxx are common to GSM and UMTS implementations to systems which are based on 3GPP specifications, and which use either a GSM/EDGE radio access network or a UTRA Radio Access Network (UTRAN) (or both).

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Note: 11.10 1 exists as a Release 1999 specification, but was closed at meeting number 32 of ETSI TC SMG (June 2000). Its contents are thus out of date, and it cannot be reliably used for conformance testing. In fact, the The Release 1999 mobile station conformance specifications are contained in the corresponding Release 4 specifications, 51.010-1 to -4 [2], [3], [4] and [5].
