### 4 General

Specifications in the range 41.xxx to 53.xxx are 'pure' GSM specs - that is, those only required to build systems which are based on 3GPP specifications and which use a GSM/EDGE Radio Access Network (GERAN). Those Specifications in the range 21.xxx to 35.xxx are common to GSM and UMTS implementations systems which are based on 3GPP specifications, and which use either a GSM/EDGE radio access network or a UTRA Radio Access Network (UTRAN) (or both).

GSM Release 4 consists of GSM only specifications and common specifications developed for both GSM Release 4 and Release 4 of the 3<sup>rd</sup>-Generation mobile system.

The present document identifies the GSM system set of specifications required to implement GSM Release 4.

Specifications for GSM only Release 4 can be identified by the "**ab.cde''** numbering scheme where "ab" is in the range 41 to 52.

Specifications for both GSM Release 4 and Release 4 of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Generation mobile system are identified by the "**ab.cde"** numbering scheme where "ab" is in the range 21 to 35.

A more detailed description of the specification numbering scheme is given in 3GPP TR 21.900.
