## 6 Specifications and Reports

Specifications in the range 01.xx to 13.xx are 'pure' GSM specs - that is, those only required to build systems which are based on 3GPP specifications and which use a GSM/EDGE Radio Access Network (GERAN). Specifications in the range 21.xxx to 35.xxx are common to systems which are based on 3GPP specifications, and which use either a GSM/EDGE radio access network or a UTRA Radio Access Network (UTRAN) (or both).

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Note: The Release 1999 mobile station conformance specifications are contained in the corresponding Release 4 specifications, 51.010-1 to -4 [2], [3], [4] and [5].
