


SA1 General Progress

- Focus on Release 6
- Major focus remains on IMS and Messaging
- Significant activity this period on IMS scenarios
- Still no significant inputs on work items for future releases

Messaging (1/2)

- Progress during Messaging SWG:
 - Held a joint meeting with T2 on MMS rel 6 issues
 - Paul Carpenter (RIM) was appointed chairman of the Sub Working Group
- Considering the possibility of an additional joint meeting with T2



Messaging (2/2)

- Outputs
 - Processed 22 documents
 - Produced two liaison statements:
 - To T2, GSM Association SerG on MM7 enhancements
 - To GSM Association BARG on roaming awareness
 - Produced two change requests to 22.140
 - On prioritisation definition and charging principle

- On preferred delivery mechanism
- Produced one change request to 22.115
 - On roaming awareness in CRDs



IMS

- A dedicated meeting held Rome was able to progress TR 22.800 IMS Subscription and access scenarios.
 SA1 concluded in email approval that the TR has reached the 50% completion, and is thus ready to be presented to SA for information (version 1.0.0).
 - SA1 still need to perform the selection of the scenarios and requirements to be endorsed.
 - SA1 present plans are to submit it for approval at the TSG-SA#20.
 - SA plenary feedback requested to verify that work is on right track.
- A CR agreed on GUP requirements to 22.228.
- SA1 agreed on revised CR on SIM access to IMS for release 5.
 - Question to SA, Which releases SIM access to IMS shall be supported. SA1 didn't have conclusion on release 6.

GUP

- Report of last GUP SWG can be found in S1-030157
- Meeting progressed with next version of GUP Stage 1, TS22.240 version 1.3.0 which can be found in S1-030209
- Primary changes were related to the refinements of the requirements for synchronisation and data consistency
- Consensus that TS22.240 has reached the 80% completion milestone and recommends SA approval
 - Details of changes since SA#17 can be found in S1-030208
- Two incoming LS from SA2 and one from SA2 were handled with responses in S1-030212 and S1-030218
- Issues to be addressed at next SA1
 - Contents of GUP should be standardised
 - Security section would benefit from a distinction between requestor and recipient of GUP data
- SWG still lacks a permanent chair and a permanent editor for TS 22.240



OSA

- R6 requirements stable
- An updated version of the WID for OSA R6 was created (S1-030178). This WID reflects the requirements that are actually covered in R6. This updated WID will give a better visibility to CN5 on the workload they shall expect for R6.





Network Sharing (1/2)

General

- The current chairman will step down from the next meeting. Telia will propose a candidate to take over
- The work has now moved to a new phase and the SWG has started to draft change requests to the existing stage 1 documents to support network sharing



Network Sharing (2/2)

- Progress during Network Sharing SWG in SF:
 - Agreed the following change requests:
 - CR to 22.951 to clarify scenario 2 and 4 and to introduce new text in the network requirements paragraph
 - CR to 22.951 to enable dynamic allocation of visiting international roamers.
 - CR to 22.101 a new paragraph 4.2 to collect specific requirements for network sharing
 - CR to 22.129 to create requirements for handover in a shared network
 - CR to 22.115 to create requirements for charging in a shared network



Priority

- CR proposed for approval
 - S1-030185 proposed CR to TS 22.950 addressing progression of priority level when interworking with external networks.
- WID proposed for approval
 - S1-030129 proposed WID for a Multimedia Priority Service Feasibility Study.
- Progressing work on a Priority Service Guide
 - Intended to describe how existing 3GPP specifications could be used to offer a Priority Service.

Smart card Issues

- Agreed to present a change request to allow SIM access to IMS for Release 5. The corresponding Release 6 CR was not agreed.
- Agreed to send a Liaison statement to SCP regarding the so called third form factor
- Partially Clarified the status of the support of SIM cards in Release 5





Other issues

GPRS

- Service examples and delay criteria added to the GPRS stage 1 description.
- Ongoing discussion on method of addressing the UE for MT services.

CAMEL

- Agreed a correction on CAMEL interworking with CLIR and COLR
- Other editorial improvements



Other issues

• LCS

- Added in stage 1 the capability for an operator to bar LCS
- Started a discussion on protective mechanisms for Registration, Erasure, Activation, Deactivation and Interrogation of the Target UE.

QoS

 Held a sub working group meeting where requirements for service based authorisation and policing per IP flow and Support for charging per IP flow were agreed in principle.
