Proposed change affects: UICC apps#

Clause 18.2.2 specifies that the CSE shall be able to change the presentation indicator of the calling party number for Mobile Originated (MO) and Mobile Forwarded (MF) calls. The stage 2 specification for CAMEL, however, allows this for MO calls only. Refer to TS 23.078 clauses 4.6.2.6 and 4.6.2.9 (description of Calling Party Restriction Indicator.)

The technical reason for this is that when a MF call is handled by CAMEL, then the Calling Party Number pertains to the Original Calling Subscriber, who is not the CAMEL subscriber. Hence, the CAMEL service should not be allowed to affect CLIR in this case.

The text in clause 18.2.2. in TS 22.078 therefore needs to be corrected accordingly.

This includes deleting the reference to "IPLMN" as this is relevant for MF calls only. (MO calls are placed in the VPLMN.)

Interaction with COLR

Clause 18.2.4 specifies that the CSE shall be able to change the presentation indicator of the connected party number for Mobile Terminated (MT) calls. The stage 2 specification for CAMEL, however, allows this for Mobile Originated (MO), Mobile Forwarded (MF), Mobile Terminated (MT) and Mobile Terminated calls in the VMSC (VT.) Refer to TS 23.078 clauses 4.6.2.6 and 4.6.2.9 (description of Connected Number Treatment Indicator.)

The tecnical reason for this is that the CAMEL Service may want to prevent that the calling subscriber gets the connected number presented on her display. As an example, you set up a call, but the CAMEL Service connects you to a voice mail box system for a security announcement. The CAMEL Service does not want the calling subscriber to get the Connected Number presented on the display, since the subscriber in that case could call the security destination directly. This kind of functionality may be applied to all call types.

The text in clause 18.2.4 in TS 22.078 therefore needs to be corrected accordingly.

This includes adding a reference to "IPLMN" as the functionality is valid also for MO and MF calls.

18.2.1 Calling Line Identification Presentation (CLIP)

The CSE shall be able to create or modify an additional calling line identity (additional calling party number) which is presented to the called subscriber via the CLIP supplementary service. There shall be no restriction to the format of the additional calling line identity determined by the CSE.

The CSE shall not be able to modify the calling line identity (calling party number).

18.2.2 Calling Line Identification Restriction (CLIR)

For an MT call or an MF call, the CSE shall not be able to change the presentation indicator given to the called subscriber via the CLIP supplementary service.

18.2.3 Connected Line Identification Presentation (COLP)

18.2.4 Connected Line Identification Restriction (COLR)
