Reason for change:	⌘	Miscellaneous Corrections of the definitions of newly introduced Wireless Number Portability (WNP) ASN.1 fields.
Summary of change:	⌘	Several new ASN.1 fields associated with WNP were introduced with the wrong type and case (i.e., ENUMERATED instead of INTEGER; Octet String Size 1..5 instead of Size 5 and the use of upper initial letter case).
Consequences if not approved:	⌘	Encoding errors of the WNP fields in the CDRs will result.
