A GLOBAL INITIATIVE

General

- ï Around 90 people attended the WS that was held in Sophia Antipolis, June 22-23
- ï The WS identified a number of technical topics of interest to both ETSI TISPAN and 3GPP
- ï The WS also endorsed a set of principles for further cooperation between 3GPP and ETSI TISPAN

Main Principles Endorsed by the WS

- ï **3GPP drives & maintains IMS core specifications**
 - ñ **Single set of specifications (for Core IMS) is the goal**
- ï **TISPAN develops independent set of specifications, not regarded as in the IMS core;**
- ï **TISPAN coordinates 3GPP NGN Dependencies & Priorities on issue level**
- ï **It is the responsibility for companies to contribute to 3GPP to introduce support for an NGN platform**
- ï **Joint understanding of IMS platform requirements for NGN → approval within 3GPP**

Issues for 3GPP to consider

- ï Creation/approval of relevant work items and related work process**
- ï ETSI TISPAN need Published Standards for referencing**
 - ñ The first ETSI TISPAN Release is planned to be finished mid-2005, hence 3GPP should look into a mechanism to ensure that Published Standards can be available for referencing before Release 7 is frozen**
 - ï The ì Early Implementationî process could potentially be used**
- ï 3GPP may also consider if it is beneficial to arrange a follow up WS in the February/March timeframe, as suggested at the WS**
