S3 LI has reviewed TR 33.800, V0.3.5 and has found no detrimental implications for lawful intercept.

The security principles outlined drives interception of call and session control to the source of the control, which the current interception architecture supports. Furthermore, it is our understanding that the document does not address user (bearer) plane security so that bearer delivery to the law agency is not impacted.
