6.6 Access link data confidentiality

6.6.1 General

User data and some signalling information elements are considered sensitive and <u>shouldmust</u> be confidentiality protected. To ensure identity confidentiality (see section 6.1), the temporary user identity (P-)TMSI <u>shouldmust</u> be transferred in a protected mode at allocation time and at other times when the signalling procedures permit it.

These needs for a protected mode of transmission are fulfilled by a confidentiality function which is applied on dedicated channels between the ME and the RNC.
