- 2) Obtain the latest version for the release of the specification to which the change is proposed. Use the MS Word "revision marks" feature (also known as "track changes") when making the changes. All 3GPP specifications can be

## 7.1 Security association parameters

- 3. The P-CSCF is allowed to receive only REGISTER messages on unprotected ports. All other messages not arriving on a protected port shall be <u>either discarded rejected</u> by the P-CSCF in <u>conformance with the procedures described in RFC3261</u>.
- 4. The UE is allowed to receive only the following messages on an unprotected port:
  - responses to unprotected REGISTER messages;
  - error messages.

All other messages not arriving on a protected port shall be silently discarded by the UE.
