## 7.3.1.2 Network authentication failure

If the UE is not able to successfully authenticate the network, the UE shall send a REGISTER message which may pass through an already established SA, indicating <u>a-the</u> network authentication failure., to the P-CSCF. The P-CSCF deletes the new SAs after receiving this message.

NOTE: In P-CSCF the already established SAs will automatically expire after the temporary lifetime of them expires.

## 7.3.1.3 Synchronisation failure

In this situation, the UE observes that the AUTN sent by the network in SM6 contains an out-of-range sequence number. The UE shall send a REGISTER message to the P-CSCF, which may pass through an already established SA, indicating the synchronization failure. The P CSCF deletes the new SAs after receiving this message.

NOTE: In P-CSCF the already established SAs will automatically expire after the temporary lifetime of them expires.
