The ATIS Packet Technologies and Systems Committee (PTSC) (formerly known as T1S1) convened a session of its LAES SubCommittee on October 26, 27 and 28, 2005. An interim, virtual meeting had also been convened on September 6, 7, & 9, 2005.

- Relative to LAES for Voice over Packet-mode technologies (T1.678, v2), comment consideration of the responses to the ATIS Letter Ballot of the proposed standard was executed. A default letter ballot will be initiated, with an eye towards likely publication early in 2006 as ATIS 1000678.2006. The resulting baseline document is available at <a href="http://contributions.atis.org/UPLOAD/PTSC/LAES/PTSC-LAES-2005-002R10.doc">http://contributions.atis.org/UPLOAD/PTSC/LAES/PTSC-LAES-2005-002R10.doc</a>. Furthermore, a new work activity has been initiated to create an addendum to this standard that would specify LAES for advanced conferencing with Voice over Packet-mode technologies.
- Relative to LAES for IP Network Access, the group agreed upon the basic approach to using the IPNetworkAccessReport Message. The resulting baseline document is available at http://contributions.atis.org/UPLOAD/PTSC/LAES/PTSC-LAES-2005-003R6.doc.
- Relative to LAES for NGN, an initial baseline document is to be created from contributions PTSC-LAES-2005-128 and '129.
- Relative to ANS J-STD-025-B, the second default ballot is scheduled to close on November 17, 2005.
- Relative to a job aid for Telecommunications Service Providers concerning the relationship of LAES standards, an initial baseline document is to be created from contribution PTSC-LAES-2005-117.
