Michael Truss is a Distinguished Member of Technical Staff in Motorola's Operation Support System Division (OSSD). He studied at Cork Institute of Technology, where he received a B.Sc. in Applied Physics.

In 1989, he joined Motorola. He worked on testing and development of Motorola's first GSM OMC and deployment of Motorola's first GSM Network in 1992. Subsequently he worked on the development, testing and deployment of Motorola's GSM Q3 Interface.

He actively participated on behalf of Motorola in the European Telecommunications Standards Institute (ETSI) between 1997 and 1999.
