

Guidelines for Meeting with Taiwanese Delegations

1. India does not have diplomatic relations with Taiwan.
2. Taiwan should not be referred to as "Republic of China (ROC)"
3. India maintains only commercial, cultural and people to people contacts with Taiwan. The India Taipei Association (ITA) in Taipei and Taipei Economic and Cultural Centre (TECC) in New Delhi are offices to facilitate exchanges between India and Taiwan.
4. They should travel on a regular (blue) passport and not on official or diplomatic passport.
5. There should not be any display of national flag, country name plate, national emblem or singing of the national anthem of India during the meeting with the Taiwanese side.
6. They should refrain from attending any public function of political nature.
7. They should not make any political statements/comments during their stay in Taiwan. Speeches/Interviews which are economic/cultural/consular/academic in nature could be considered after obtaining prior clearance from ITA Taipei both on the desirability along with the subject matter and content.
8. There should be no publicity about the meeting/visit.
9. We should not associate ourselves with any publicity material containing references to "Republic of China (ROC)", its flag, its emblem and so on.
10. There shall be no reference to the term "Republic of China (ROC)" in any document signed during the visit.
11. Signing of any "inter-governmental" documents with Taiwan including between State Governments and provincial level organizations in Taiwan is not permitted.
12. Approved route for Government Officials traveling to Taiwan is via Bangkok/Singapore, where applicable. Specific approval may be sought from Ministry of External Affairs in case of transit through any other airport.
13. As far as possible, visit to Taiwan is to be undertaken as a stand-alone visit.
14. Visit along with programme elements shall be planned in consultation with ITA Taipei.
